

In 2022, Aria Hotels signed a first-of-its-kind agreement with Libra Group's aviation subsidiary, LCI, to lease 10 electric vertical take-off and landing aircraft (eVTOLs), allowing guests to traverse the Greek isles in a sustainable, cost-efficient, safe way. In 2024, Aria Hotels announced that it will build and operate four vertiports to support the eVTOLs.

2009

The Aria Hotels story began in 2009 with the acquisition of The Windmill in Kimolos Island, and the conversion of a traditional Greek windmill dating from 1852 into a boutique hotel.

2010 - 2016

From Kimolos, Aria Hotels continued on to Crete with Alcanea Boutique Hotel and other diverse properties in island and mainland destinations including beachfront hotels, secluded villas, mountain resorts and wine tourism retreats.

2017

Aria decided to invest in the historical Athens center, envisaging the booming of the capital's market. Currently, the Athens portfolio has four properties including an impressive boutique hotel, La Divina, in the historic building of the ex-Odeon Atheneum.

2019

One of the most important and beautiful mansion of Greece is added in Aria Hotels Portfolio. Patrick & Joan Leigh Fermor House in Kardamyli becomes the flagship. At the same time, Aria expands to the prestigious Mykonos island with the emblematic five-star boutique hotel, Grace Mykonos.

2020 - 2022

Aria's collection is famous for the diversity of the properties and destinations, and couldn't be complete without an exclusive private island, Pegassus, close to Evia island that has been added to the portfolio, along with and ranges from suites in the heart of Athens to an exclusive mountain boutique hotel, suites, beach houses to popular destinations like Crete, Cyclades, Peloponnese, Sporades, Dodecanese, Athens, Evia and the Ionian Islands.

2024

Today the company has grown to over 60 properties all over Greece preserving the authentic character of the properties and destinations, always following the principles that was founded 15 years ago.





Double Rooms, offering all modern comforts and amenities. This intimate boutique hotel is ideal for couples.





Samaria Gorge Hiking Adventure



Exploring the Old Town & Palamidi Fortress


